

Extension of the Deadline for Submissions to the Consultation on Arrangements for the Frequency Spectrum in the 2.5/2.6 GHz Band upon Expiry of the Existing Assignments for the Provision of Public Mobile Services and the Related Spectrum Utilisation Fee

The Commerce and Economic Development Bureau and the Office of the Communications Authority (“OFCA”) announced today (14 October 2020) that the deadline for submissions to the consultation paper issued on 23 September 2020 on “*Arrangements for the Frequency Spectrum in the 2.5/2.6 GHz Band upon Expiry of the Existing Assignments for the Provision of Public Mobile Services and the Related Spectrum Utilisation Fee*” has been extended by three weeks to 10 November 2020.

The extension is made in response to requests from the industry, so that interested parties could have more time to submit their written views on the consultation paper. With this extension, the industry and interested parties will have a total of seven weeks for submitting their views and comments.

All submissions to the consultation paper should reach OFCA by the extended deadline of 10 November 2020. Submissions made after that date would not be considered.
