Introduction

The Television and Radio Consultative Scheme (the Scheme) was introduced in 1982. The Scheme is aimed at gauging public opinions on broadcasting issues so as to assist the Communications Authority (CA) in formulating broadcasting rules that can reflect community standards.

Members join the Scheme on a voluntary basis. They are recruited with reference to the population profile of different districts in Hong Kong in terms of age, sex and occupation. The Scheme is administered by the Office of the Communications Authority (OFCA).

Consultation

Members will be invited to provide their views on broadcasting issues via mail/email/SMS, or to participate in focus group discussions. Activities will also be organised from time to time to enhance Members' understanding of the Hong Kong broadcasting industry.
