

**Public Consultation on Applications for Renewal of
Other Licensable Television Programme Service Licences**

The Communications Authority (“CA”) has received the applications from Kowloon Panda Hotel Limited (“Kowloon Panda”), Gala Hotels Limited (“Gala Hotels”), Shangri-La Hotel (Kowloon) Limited (“Shangri-La”), Bauhinia Hotels Limited (“Bauhinia Hotels”) and Sheraton International (Hong Kong) Limited (“Sheraton”), companies duly incorporated in Hong Kong, for renewal of their respective other licensable television programme service licences to provide television programme service in hotel rooms in Hong Kong via in-house telecommunications networks.
