The current 12-year licence of CETV, will expire on 30 September 2013. CETV has applied to renew its licence under section 11(2) of the Broadcasting Ordinance (Cap.562). The particulars of this application are set out below for reference:-

1. COMPANY INFORMATION

CETV is a company incorporated in Hong Kong on 4 January 1994. Its shares are held by TOM Television Group Limited (74.36%) and Historic TBS Asia LLC (25.64%). TOM Television Group Limited and Historic TBS Asia LLC are subsidiaries of TOM Group Limited and Time Warner Inc. respectively.

2. PROGRAMMING INFORMATION

CETV plans to continue to provide its non-domestic television programme service, comprising one 24-hour general entertainment channel in Putonghua. The service targets audiences in the Mainland and will not primarily target Hong Kong. The programmes are mainly sourced from the Mainland. CETV has submitted that its programming department is responsible for reviewing all contents to ensure compliance with all regulatory requirements in providing the service.

3. TECHNICAL INFORMATION

The service is uplinked from Hong Kong to AsiaSat 3S satellite. The service footprint covers the Asia Pacific region.
